<u>UPDATE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PARTNERSHIPS:</u>

Please see below for an update on the Colonial Theater project:

- Environmental remediation and abatement continues. A crew is on site managing the environmental remediation process in particular, working under the stage area currently.
- Demolition crews have removed most of the junk/debris that is under the theater stage
 and Canal St. section of the property. Several dumpsters were filled with debris and junk
 in recent weeks. This work continues, and in the past week several walls in the theater
 and old projection booths have been demolished.
- Scaffolding has been staged throughout the theater for construction crews to continue their work moving forward into the winter.
