Body: green apple, green grapes

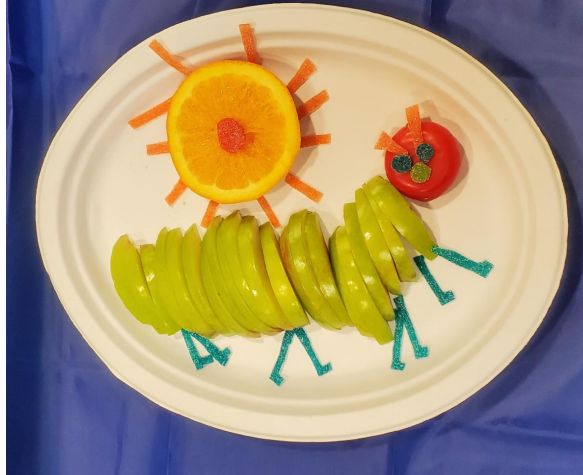
Head: circle of cheese, or Baby Belle cheese, half strawberry

Rays: fruit roll-ups or no rays


