**Synopsis of Event:**

On 07/06/19 the Laconia Police Department received information that 26 year old Aaron J. Capaldi, who was wanted out of Massachusetts for Felonious Sexual Assault, was residing at 73 Merrimack St. in Laconia. A record check revealed Capaldi also had an outstanding warrant for Criminal Threatening and Harassment out of the Laconia Police Department.

Laconia Police received additional information that Capaldi may be armed and could pose an elevated threat to law enforcement. As a result the Belknap County Regional Special Operations Group responded to assist Laconia Officers in the apprehension of Capaldi. At approximately 1718 hours, Capaldi was called out of the residence and taken into custody without incident. Capaldi was charged with being a fugitive from justice, one count of Criminal Threatening, and one count of Harassment.

Capaldi was remanded to the Belknap County Department of Corrections pending his arraignment at the 4<sup>th</sup> Circuit – District Division – Laconia Court on 07/08/19. Anyone with information regarding this incident is encouraged to contact the Laconia Police Department at (603) 524-5252.
